Chronic Disease Management Program

If you have a chronic medical condition, you may be able to get a Medicare rebate.

The Chronic Disease Management (CDM) program provides specialised individual treatment services to those with a chronic medical condition and complex care needs.

A referral from your GP is required. This referral allows you to access up to 5 allied health visits per calendar year.

Appointments seen through your CDM Plan will be bulk-billed. This means that you will not have to pay out of pocket.

We offer 30 minute clinic-based appointments for the Chronic Disease Management Program.
