IPC Health's Mental Health Service supports people who are experiencing the pressures and stresses of everyday life.

Not feeling like yourself lately? You're not alone. It's something most people experience at some point.

We take a holistic approach to supporting you and your mental health, whether you have a mental ill-health history, or it is the first time you have reached out for support.



What to expect

We have a no wrong door approach. Our mental health clinician will talk to you about your personal concerns to identify the support you need.

We then work with you to develop a package of support services suited to your individual situation. That support may be provided from within IPC Health's Mental Health Service, or we may refer you to other health providers (also free or low cost) who are better suited to support you.

IPC Health's Mental Health Service is a face-to-face service, however we also provide the option of counselling over the phone or via video call.

Who can use this service?

The IPC Health Mental Health Service supports people who live or work in Brimbank, Hobsons Bay, Wyndham, Melton and Bacchus Marsh.

People from 6 years and up as well as their families and caregivers can use this service.

A mental health treatment plan from your GP is not required.

How do I book an appointment?

Is there a fee?

The IPC Health Mental Health Service is a free short-term service that provides 12 counselling sessions.

Can I have an interpreter?

Yes, interpreters are free. Please let us know when booking an appointment.
