

What is community health?

Community health organisations focus on improving the health and wellbeing of local communities.

They also aim to educate local people about disease prevention.

Older Australians

The Australian Government service My Aged Care allows older Australians (aged 65 and over, and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people aged 50 and over) to access aged care services and programs.

If you would like help staying at home, you can apply through My Aged Care for a Home Care Package. A package gives you more control over the services you receive at home.

You can also organise services such as physiotherapy, podiatry, occupational therapy, dietetics and speech therapy through My Aged Care.

IPC Health is a registered provider with My Aged Care, so you can ask for IPC Health to be your preferred service provider.
